- Utilize proficiency in playing piano or guitar to lead full band rehearsals and/or worship services.
- Demonstrate excellence in charting songs and arranging musical elements to enhance worship dynamics.
- Embody servant leadership by prioritizing the needs of others and fostering a culture of unity, humility, and love within the worship team and congregation.
- Serve as a team player, actively contributing ideas, skills, and talents to collective worship endeavors.
